An Official Day of Thanks

Fort Warren, Massachusetts November 26, 1863

While one of the first Thanksgivings is thought to have taken place in Plymouth, Massachusetts, in the early 1600s,

it wasn't until 1863 that President Abraham Lincoln established it as an official Federal holiday. At that time, the closest weather station to Plymouth was Fort Warren, which protected Boston Harbor during the Civil War.






A light northwest wind
